

School Values and Code of Conduct including EYFS (PG 6, BG 6 P3 ISI 9a)

For West Hill Park to operate smoothly and happily, a multitude of small systems within it need to operate effectively together and members of its community need to behave in certain ways or to modify their behaviour in certain environments to ensure the school's well-being. If we tried to set out rules for behaviour in detail, they would run to many pages and still not be comprehensive.

In place of fixed rules, therefore, we prefer to set down a simple code of behaviour which we expect everyone to follow, be they pupils, staff, governors, parents and their guests or other visitors who we refer to as the whole 'Community' in our Code.

The West Hill Park School Code of Conduct:

• General

A breach of common sense is a breach of this code and School rules.

• Safety

The whole Community should behave in a manner that gives them the best chance of being safe and avoiding danger to others or damage to School property.

• Consideration

The whole Community should find every opportunity to act in a manner that demonstrates kindness, consideration and good manners to all around them.

• Appropriate behaviour

The whole Community should demonstrate behaviour and use language that is appropriate to the situation in which they are currently working.

Ambassadors

The whole Community must remember that, when away from School premises on a school trip such as an away match, they are representatives of the School in all that they do and should act in an appropriate manner at all times.

• Respect

The whole Community should at all times respect the other members of the West Hill Park community and their property. This respect extends to the animals and natural habitats of the School.

Above all, individuals and groups must treat others as they would themselves like to be treated.
